



Youth Director

Position Description

Fairview United Methodist Church is dedicated to equipping disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. As a part time member of the staff, the Youth Director will work with the Pastor and the Administrative Board to form, equip, and empower the youth and the Youth Ministry Team. This is a 10 hour per week position.

General Duties

- Leads the Youth Ministry Team
- Works with and builds programs and curriculum for the youth (Ages 6th-12th grade). This includes Sunday mornings, Wednesday Evenings, occasional Retreats, and Service Projects.
- Build activities that encourage and draw youth to our church
- Works with the pastor to develop a discipleship journey for youth to grow in Christ
- Assists the pastor with Confirmation Classes as needed
- Participates in a community partnership geared toward youth

Qualifications

- Must possess strong leadership and team building skills
- A relational – team builder who is outgoing, dynamic, and loves people
- Must clearly articulate a call to youth ministry
- Profess Jesus Christ as Lord
- Affirm, equip, and teach in accordance with the doctrines of The United Methodist Church
- Possess clear communication skills through writing, speech, witness, internet/social media
- In accordance with our Safe Sanctuary Policy the Youth Director must be five years older than the oldest participant.
- Experience in Youth Ministry is Preferred

Reporting and Authority

- The Administrative Board hires, evaluates and terminates employees of the Church
- The Youth Director reports to the pastor
- Mission Focused goals are set by the Administrative Board annually
- The Youth Director is accountable for budget and expenditures
- The Youth Director must submit to a full background check prior to being hired
- The Youth Director shall complete Safe Gatherings Training within 30 days of employment

Compensation will be determined by the Administrative Board and is based on Experience and Qualifications
